Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be dry and warm through today with plenty of sunshine. However, there will be a cooling easterly breeze, especially along the Eastern coasts. The wind quite brisk along the South Coast. A fine end to the day with largely clear skies expected tonight. Mist or low cloud affecting some eastern coasts.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Apart from an isolated shower, the warm weather will last across much of the country on both Wednesday and Thursday, with very warm conditions across much of central England. Southwestern Britain and perhaps N.Ireland will be more cloudy at times, with some showery rain.
