

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A band of snow across Scotland may give significant accumulations away from low lying areas through the day. Another band of heavy rain will sink southwards from northern England across Wales and the Midlands, with outbreaks of rain elsewhere, these wintry at first over Northern Ireland. West or southwesterly winds should ease by the evening.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Dry for most on Thursday, although rain is expected across southern England with snow showers continuing across northern Scotland. These showers will ease on Friday, but rain in southern England will spread northwards, falling as snow initially, reaching northern England by the evening.
