

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 10 Jan 2018

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Patchy light rain will continue to move across eastern parts with cloudy skies and a risk of some hill fog. However, it will be drier and brighter elsewhere, perhaps with the odd shower in the southwest. Temperatures will fall in clear spells overnight with a patchy frost and some freezing fog patches.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Any fog may be slow to clear in places on Thursday, but it should otherwise stay largely dry, with some sunshine developing in the west and north. Fog may be around again on Friday morning, but the rest of the day should stay largely dry and cloudy.
