

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 07 Jun 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Staying mostly fine and dry across Britain and feeling warm with plenty of sunshine. Scattered showers are likely to develop in places, particularly across the southwest, where they may be locally heavy and thundery. Showers generally clearing through the evening, however some may linger across Cornwall. Otherwise mostly dry overnight, but northern and eastern parts becoming increasingly cloudy towards dawn.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Remaining dry and fine for most, with warm sunny spells, although feeling slightly cooler than recently. North Sea coastal areas will probably be cloudier with some mist or fog at times and a few showers are possible across northern parts.
