

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 01 Apr 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Patchy mist clearing, then dry with variable cloud and sunny spells, the best of the sunshine likely across eastern and southern areas. Feeling warm in sunshine and light winds. Tonight, remaining dry with clear periods and turning chilly in places. However, misty low cloud will spread into parts of eastern England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Misty low cloud burning back to North Sea coasts, then both Thursday and Friday should remain dry with sunny spells and it will feel pleasantly warm in the sunshine. However, cloudier eastern coasts will be cooler and there is a risk of rain in the far west later Friday.
