Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showery rain across central and southern parts through the morning will turn persistent and heavy through the afternoon. Winds will stay strong across Scotland with squally showers but it should be drier and brighter elsewhere. The rain will clear east overnight and the showers should ease so most parts will become dry by dawn with falling temperatures and fog patches.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain across western areas will push across the whole country on Saturday with showers following. Winds will become strong with gales in places. Sunday will see sunny spells, showers and further strong winds with persistent rain across southern areas later.
