Headline:

Sunshine and heavy showers, frequent in northwest. Breezy in north.

Today:

Showery rain soon clearing southeast England. Otherwise, sunshine and showers, heavy at times, most frequent in the northwest, isolated further south and east. Blustery winds in the north. Feeling fresher.

Tonight:

Showers continuing in the northwest. Elsewhere, becoming mainly dry, clear spells. Staying breezy in the north.

Outlook for Thursday:

Mainly dry, bright start but cloud and rain extending across many central parts later.
