Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
After a dry start in the east, outbreaks of rain will spread to all parts. Much of this will be light away from western-hills, but a spell of heavier-rain is likely before skies brighten in the northwest, this reaching all but southeast-England by dusk. Blustery showers developing in the northwest, some heavy with snow on hills.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday is expected to be bright and breezy with blustery, wintry showers, heaviest in the northwest. A deep-depression will cross the UK on Monday, bringing spells of rain or showers and very strong winds in the south and west with some damaging gusts.
