Slight in east, moderate in west.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.

Moderate near St Davids Head at first, otherwise slight.

Showers, thundery rain later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

General Situation

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

South 3 to 4, veering west to northwest this afternoon, becoming variable 2 this evening, then south to southeast by midnight, increasing 2 to 4 by dawn.

Slight.

Occasional rain, drizzle and fog patches clearing during the afternoon isolated showers developing overnight.

Moderate to good, locally very poor this afternoon.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to east 2 to 4, becoming variable overnight, then mainly southwest later.

Slight with a low swell.

Scattered showers.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
