Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Eastern England will be largely dry and sunny. There will be sunny spells and showers for northern and western areas, extending south-eastwards, locally heavy with thunder. Turning colder and windier over northern Scotland. Generally dry with clear spells overnight, with a widespread frost in northwestern parts. Showers moving south across central parts, locally heavy in southeast England.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Coastal showers, perhaps heavy with thunder, especially in eastern England, easing from the northwest Wednesday. Mainly dry and sunny elsewhere with a fine and locally frosty Bonfire night to follow. Thursday starts dry, but turning wet and windy from the west later.
