

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 03 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will clear eastern areas during the morning, then sunny with showers.  
Southern areas will be mainly dry, with showers across Northern Ireland,  
Scotland, northern England and along the east coast. Occasionally brisk  
northwesterly winds. Overnight, outbreaks of rain will spread to Scotland and  
Northern Ireland, and northern England by dawn. Strengthen southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain and strong winds will affect Scotland, Northern Ireland, much of Wales,  
central and northern England. Southernmost counties of England will be pleasant,  
brighter and largely dry. Southern counties of England and Wales will be largely  
dry and bright on Tuesday. Rain at times further north.
