Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will be dry with variable amounts of cloud. Some bright or sunny spells are likely, except perhaps the far NW of Scotland which will be duller with occasional light rain. Little change tonight, most places dry with variable amounts of cloud allowing some mist or fog patches to form in western parts. NW Scotland still cloudy and damp.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Once again most places will be dry with variable cloud cover and some bright or sunny spells, particularly in the southwest. NW Scotland will remain damp with some mainly light rain and drizzle at times. Feeling warm in any sunshine.
