Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will have a fine, bright day with sunny spells, with southern England and Wales seeing the best of the sunshine. Scotland may see the odd shower, but other places will remain dry. Winds easing in the north. Overnight, dry, clear and chilly for most, with a few mist or fog patches in England and Wales by morning.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Northern, particularly northwestern, Scotland and the north of Northern Ireland becoming wet and windy on Thursday, with some rain still on Friday. Elsewhere, both days essentially dry and warm with sunny spells, with the most prolonged sunshine in the south.
