Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Very unsettled, outbreaks of rain in Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England, turning to snow across Scottish mountains. A sunny start for many elsewhere, then showers, some heavy, perhaps with hail and thunder, soon developing widely. Showers in west less frequent in afternoon. Quite windy over south of England and Wales. Increasingly cold in northern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday, wintry showers in Scotland, perhaps significant accumulations of snow in the northwest. Showers also becoming wintry in Northern Ireland. Eastern England rather cloudy with showers, brighter further west. Tuesday, wintry showers in north, mainly dry with sunny spells in south. Rather cold.
