#### General Situation

A slow moving low will remain centred southwards from Iceland. Associated fronts will affect northern and western parts of the United Kingdom. Across the North Sea pressure remaining relatively high.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, but southeasterly 4 in east.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, but southeasterly 4 or 5 for a time in east.

Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in far north and east.

Rain or showers, fog patches developing.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A southeasterly airflow has become established across Shetland. Fronts embedded in the flow will bring rain and drizzle, at times.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeasterly 4 or 3, decreasing 3 in west.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 01 Aug until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, but 3 in west at first.  
Moderate or good.

Occasional rain and drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable or southerly 2 to 3, occasionally 4, becoming mainly north to northeast by evening.

Smooth or slight.

Mist and fog patches some rain mainly in the west of the area.

Moderate or good, locally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 2 to 3, becoming variable overnight then westerly by morning.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist or fog patches risk of showers later Tuesday.

Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor in any mist or fog.

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
