

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most parts will be dry with warm sunshine today. However, areas of cloud will spread north giving the chance of a shower, and it will turn breezy. Overnight, rain will spread eastwards across all areas. Clear spells are likely in the east at first and it will become clearer with blustery showers in the northwest later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will clear from southeast England leaving a fresher day on Saturday. The south will have plenty of sunshine, whilst blustery wintry showers are likely in the northwest. Further rain is possible across central areas on Sunday. Brighter elsewhere, but showery in the north.
