Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting misty and foggy in many central and southeastern areas, but brighter in the west. Some drizzle on eastern hills and coasts, while in the southwest there may be a few sharp and possibly thundery showers in the morning. The cloud will break up in most areas but the northeast will stay cloudy and drizzly. Feeling warm in sunshine.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A cloudy start on Saturday but with a few breaks in the south and west. Drizzle on eastern hills and coasts drying up through the day. Becoming sunnier and warmer in the afternoon. Dry and bright in all areas on Sunday.
