Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It is a largely cloudy start across much of England and Wales with rain at times, occasionally heavy for some, although it should slowly brighten up. Most places will remain dry, however the north of Scotland and Northern Ireland will have a few showers at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday will start fine for many but cloud, wind and rain will spread up from the south-west. This will turn heavier and more persistent during the afternoon and it will become windy across southern counties. By Sunday we'll see a brief respite with some brighter spells and a few showers across eastern parts.
