

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a frosty, locally foggy start across northwestern areas but a dry and largely sunny day will follow, except for some persistent fog in central Scotland. Elsewhere, cloud and occasional drizzle will spread across remaining parts of England and Wales, continuing northwestwards across most parts overnight. However, the far northwest of Scotland will stay dry, clear and frosty.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be generally rather cloudy with a few spots of drizzle but some brighter spells are possible across northwest Scotland at first. It will be milder on Wednesday, with more persistent rain spreading to western parts of the UK.
