Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Any early cloud and patchy rain the southeast England will clear. It will be dry for most with sunny spells and feel warm in the sunshine. Northern and western Scotland will stay windy with heavy showers. Bands of locally heavy, showery rain will cross northern areas overnight. Some rain or drizzle arriving in the southwest and west Wales later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Dry with sunny spells and scattered showers for many on Monday. Cloudier in the west with light rain or drizzle in the southwest. Feeling pleasantly warm in the sunshine. Rain on Tuesday across some central and northern parts, sunny spells elsewhere.
