Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After a wet start across England and Wales, rain should become increasingly confined to southeastern areas with further heavy outbreaks and perhaps the odd rumble of thunder. It will be drier and brighter elsewhere, but remaining breezy. Rain will become confined to the extreme southeast overnight, with a largely dry and chilly night elsewhere in clear spells.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be mostly dry with sunny spells after rain clears the far southeast in the morning. There may also be some light patchy rain in the far north. Wet and windy conditions will return on Friday, with heavy bursts in the northwest.
