Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Eastern parts mostly dry and sunny. However, plenty of sleet and snow showers are expected in the north and west, some of them heavy at times. A few snow showers may blow across to the east, especially in the afternoon. Cold and breezy, with moderate to fresh westerly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most parts dry with plenty of sunshine on Tuesday, but staying cold, and with more cloud and some snow showers likely across northern Scotland and some exposed western and eastern coasts elsewhere. Most places will then be cloudier, but less cold on Wednesday, with a little rain in the north.
