

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 07 Apr 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy with rain, sleet and hill snow for northern Scotland. Elsewhere, a frosty start, sunshine turning hazier as cloud increases from the west. Light winds, becoming breezy in the southwest during the morning, some light rain later. Frost forming overnight under clearer spells, though less widespread than of late.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Many areas bright or some hazy sunshine. Isolated showers in northeastern parts, sleet or hill snow in Scotland easing. Rain becoming more widespread in the south on Tuesday, at times heavy, but temperatures a little higher. Northern Britain staying cold and windy. Wintry showers, a longer spell of hill snow possible.
