Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of heavy rain will spread from central parts of the UK, across some northeastern parts. Elsewhere, it will be a mix of bright spells and heavy, occasionally thundery showers, some of which could be torrential, particularly across southern England. However, it will be fine and dry across Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will remain unsettled across southern and eastern parts, with brisk winds and outbreaks of rain. These will be locally heavy on Saturday, but should ease during Sunday. Across northern and western parts, it will be largely fine, although nights are likely to be chilly, with patchy frost and fog.
