

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 12 Oct 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A chilly start with dense fog patches slowly dispersing. A few showers in the north, otherwise largely dry with sunny spells. Southern areas becoming cloudier and breezier in the afternoon, with locally heavy rain and stronger winds spreading north and west overnight. However Scotland, Northern Ireland and probably the far north of England, mostly dry with patchy frost and fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Much of England and Wales cloudy and breezy with spells of locally heavy rain on Monday. Risk of gales for some eastern coastal parts. Further north remaining largely dry with sunny spells. Tuesday, rain across some eastern parts slowly clearing.
