Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northern Britain will be mainly dry and bright with plenty of sunshine at first, this continuing around many coasts. Elsewhere, there will be large amounts of cloud with perhaps some drizzle at first. Some brighter, warmer spells are possible for a time, but rain, occasionally heavy, will spread northeast later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Wet and decidedly cold across much of Wales and central and southern England on Sunday, with the rain occasionally heavy. Brighter and mostly dry to the north and perhaps brighter in Southwest England too. Rain becoming confined to the far southeast on Monday with brighter conditions elsewhere spreading slowly south.
