Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain over southern Britain slowly easing away with brighter skies following from the north. Blustery showers developing in places, these perhaps heavy in the north and slow-moving over Scotland. Very windy everywhere, with gales along southern coasts easing.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Staying unsettled on Wednesday with scattered showers, mostly in the north where some may be heavy and thundery. Still windy but winds generally lighter than Tuesday. Northern Britain will probably have a drier day with sunny spells and a few isolated showers on Thursday but southern areas will probably turn cloudier with outbreaks of rain developing, heaviest in the southwest.
