

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry day with sunshine for many. Scattered showers will continue in parts of the west and especially northwest, although these will be fewer and lighter than of late. During the evening, rain will spread eastwards across the north, becoming heavy and rather persistent overnight with strengthening winds. Meanwhile southern UK should stay dry with clear spells throughout.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Occasionally heavy rain will move slowly southeast, reaching all but the dry but increasingly cloudy southeast of England on Sunday, later moving through here on Monday. Meanwhile, scattered blustery showers and sunny spells will follow behind, moving in on brisk winds.
