Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Generally dry with sunny periods, after early patchy mist and low cloud quickly clears. However, north and northwest Scotland remaining cloudy with patchy light rain, with cloud also lingering across southeast England and East Anglia. Temperatures nearer normal under the cloudier skies, otherwise warm or locally very warm.

This evening and overnight becoming cloudy across much of Scotland and Northern Ireland, with rain across northern mainland Scotland. Elsewhere dry, clear periods, patchy mist and fog.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday:-Patchy rain across northern and northeast Scotland. Otherwise dry, with sunny spells. Warm or very in many places.

Sunday:-Cloudier in many areas, scattered showers.
