Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
A dry start in the east, with some early sunshine. However, cloud and occasional squally showers, already in the west, will spread to most other parts. The showers heavy and thundery in places, perhaps giving a prolonged spell of rain. A windy day, with gales in the northwest, and gusty in heavier showers. Temperatures near normal but feeling chilly in the wind.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy and persistent rain, already in the far southwest at dawn Sunday, will spread quickly to all other areas. Very windy with gales or severe gales. Staying unsettled on Monday with rain or blustery showers in many areas.
