

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 09 Feb 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most western and northern areas will have outbreaks of rain. Further southeast it should remain largely dry with bright spells, and just the odd spot of rain. The rain will become heavier and more persistent for a time overnight and edge eastwards, clearing Scotland and Northern Ireland later in the night allowing a frost and patchy fog to develop.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Scotland and Northern Ireland will be dry with sunny spells on Thursday apart from isolated fog patches. Elsewhere, it will remain mild with further rain at times, especially during the morning. Wet and increasingly windy conditions returning to everyone on Friday.
