Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a cold start in northern areas of the UK it will be mostly dry with sunny spells. Southwesterly winds strengthening through the day with gales in northwest Scotland later. It will be cloudier and warmer elsewhere. Isolated showers are possible in southern England, but most places will remain dry with sunny spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Wet and windy conditions across Scotland and Northern Ireland Friday will move slowly southeastwards. Drier and mainly cloudy conditions further south with sunny spells for many. Wind and rain continuing south-eastwards Saturday, clearing southeast England later. Cooler, clearer conditions following, with frequent showers in west. Remaining breezy.
