Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain will linger over many parts of Scotland, heaviest in the west. Elsewhere:  
mostly cloudy, mild with patchy drizzle in places but also a few brighter spells  
developing in the south and east. It will be on the mild side for February with  
temperatures of 11 to 13C quite widely.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Northwest Britain will continue to be rather damp at times, but elsewhere it  
should be mostly fine and dry but often fairly cloudy. The best of the  
brightness will be in the south and east but there could also be some patchy  
frost and fog by night.
