Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A frosty start in places with a few fog patches. Then a dry day for much of the UK with lengthy spells of sunshine. However a few showers are likely to affect some coastal areas at times. Remaining largely dry and clear at first tonight, with frost forming widely. But clouding over in the north, with outbreaks of rain.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloud will continue southwards on Tuesday, bringing some patchy rain or drizzle. Drier and brighter in the south, and to the south of hills. Largely cloudy and breezy on Wednesday, with patchy rain or drizzle at times. Milder than of late.
