#### General Situation

High pressure will continue to build over Scotland as low pressure develops over France.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast, becoming variable, 2 to 4, then northeast 4 or 5 later in Moray Firth.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5 at first in Moray Firth, otherwise variable 2 to 4, becoming east 3 to 5 later.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery later in south.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers developing in south, perhaps thundery.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later in south.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in east.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southwest 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight except near Isles of Scilly.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in Bristol Channel, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 4 to 6.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate except in Cardigan Bay.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate until later in west, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 4 to 6.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in southwest.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly or northeasterly, veering southeasterly in south, 4 to 6.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers in south.  
Good.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 3 to 5.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, perhaps occasionally 6 mid-channel for a time after dawn, becoming variable 1 to 3 in the south in the afternoon.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate to rather rough in the north of the area after dawn.

Showers, locally heavy and thundery, mostly clearing by midday, fog patches with occasional drizzle developing overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor, becoming moderate to very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 then gradually west to northwest 3 to 5 after dawn, backing west to southwest later.

Smooth or slight with a low swell, locally moderate in the north of the area at first.

Rain or showers developing overnight, locally heavy and perhaps thundery, clearing later, fog banks, clearing later.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor or very poor for a time.

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
