

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Western Scotland, Northern Ireland and northwest England will be rather cloudy with some rain or drizzle at times, though this should die out from the south later. Strong winds should gradually ease down. Elsewhere, it will be dry with bright or sunny spells, best sunshine in the east. It will be generally mild or very mild everywhere.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be mostly dry, but cloudy, though some sunshine is likely in places, especially in the east. A little rain will spread southeastwards on Friday, followed by sunnier skies. It will remain mild in most places, though windy in the north.
