Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It should be fairly cloudy across much of England, with scattered showers, possibly turning to sleet and snow over hills. Showers will tend to die out during the evening. For the majority of Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales, it should be mostly dry with some sunshine at times. It will be a chilly day, with light north to northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Cold over the weekend, with cloudy conditions likely to remain, and scattered sleet or snow showers mainly confined to eastern England. Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland should be drier, but rain is expected to spread from the northwest on Sunday.
