Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
England, Wales and Northern Ireland will have a cloudy morning with outbreaks of rain, these heavy in some western areas and falling as sleet or snow on northern hills. As the day goes on colder but drier and brighter weather across Scotland will follow southwards to all but the far south of England and Wales.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday rain in the south and west will move slowly northeastwards, turning increasingly to sleet or snow across northern areas as it does so. However northeastern Scotland will remain mainly dry with sunny spells. Thursday will be wet and windy at times.
