Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rather cloudy over central, south and southeast England, with scattered showery outbreaks of rain, perhaps heavy later. Otherwise, sunny spells and showers becoming widespread, heavy and thundery over northern and later western areas. The rain or showers spreading east across most parts overnight. Gales or severe gales over far northwest Scotland at first easing later. Temperatures near average.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Cloudy with rain over southern Scotland and northern England on Monday. Mainly dry over northern Scotland, sunny spells and frequent heavy showers elsewhere. Dry start in east on Tuesday but rain in west spreading across most parts by lunchtime. Temperatures near average.
