Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A chilly start, with frost for many and a few fog patches too. Then a largely dry day with some bright or sunny spells. However, rain in the far north will spread across Scotland through the day, where it will become milder but increasingly windy.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Both Wednesday and Thursday will be largely cloudy. On Wednesday, the cloud could be thick enough for a few spots of rain, mainly across Scotland at first, but spreading southwards through the day. Thursday will be a largely dry day. On both nights, any cloud breaks will lead to a risk of frost and fog.
