Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A dull, grey start for many with low cloud, mist or fog patches. Cloud and rain will spread across Scotland and Northern Ireland during the day, whilst a few bright or sunny intervals slowly develop across England and Wales. It will be mild in all areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cloud and rain will move erratically southeast across England and Wales during Wednesday, followed by sunshine and scattered showers on Thursday. Showers may turn to snow over higher ground in the north during the day. Mild at first, turning colder in many areas from the north during Thursday.
