

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a cold start, any fog patches will lift to leave a fine morning for most with plenty of sunshine. Showers will affect some eastern coastal parts of England and these will spread inland through the day, but most western areas will remain dry throughout. Despite this, it will remain chilly, especially in the wind.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most areas will stay dry on Thursday but further showers will affect southeastern areas with more persistent rain across the far north. Similar conditions will continue into Friday although any persistent rain will gradually die out. It will stay chilly with further frosts overnight.
