Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Northern Ireland and western Scotland will be cloudy, breezy and wet today. Other western coasts will become damp too. Elsewhere mainly fine and dry with sunny spells. Very warm in the southeast. Cloudy with rain at times across the north and west tonight. Mainly dry elsewhere with the clearest skies and some mist patches developing to the southeast.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Dry with occasional sunny spells for most of England and Wales, sunniest in the southeast. Thicker cloud and rain will affect Northern Ireland and western Scotland, occasionally spreading further east. Very warm in the south, just above normal in the north.
