

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Patchy rain extending from the southwest to northeast England will gradually weaken and clear the far southeast by late afternoon. Clearer conditions will follow from the northwest, being cooler, windy with heavy wintry showers in the north of Scotland. Elsewhere there will be a good deal of dry weather and sunny spells.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Wet and windy in the northwest from Saturday morning, rain slowly and erratically spreading southeast. Remaining largely dry further south, with sunny spells in the far southeast of England. The patchy rain spreading slowly southwards through Sunday and weakening, with some warm sunshine maintaining in the far southeast.
