

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Sunday 09 Nov 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

An area of very heavy rain will move eastwards across the southern half of Wales and England during Monday, clearing away again from southern Wales during the afternoon but lingering in southeastern England until well after dusk.

Northwestern Scotland will have gales and driving rain, with snow on higher ground. Elsewhere, isolated showers, although many places will remain dry.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be a very windy day with a mixture of sunny intervals and scattered showers, although some northern areas will be cloudy with more general rain.

Wednesday will be a mostly dry day with sunny spells and lighter winds.
