Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Scattered showers this morning, with a few heavy ones across eastern England, plus longer spells of rain for western Scotland and northwest England. This afternoon the rain and showers will die away, allowing sunny spells to develop. Breezy, with temperatures near average. Overnight cloud and rain will spread across Northern Ireland, Wales, western England and western Scotland. Elsewhere dry, fine.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday Northern Ireland dry and bright morning, then rain arriving late afternoon. Elsewhere cloudy with patchy rain, then becoming dry and bright, although later further rain for Wales, northwest England and southern Scotland. Monday rain across Wales and northwest England.
