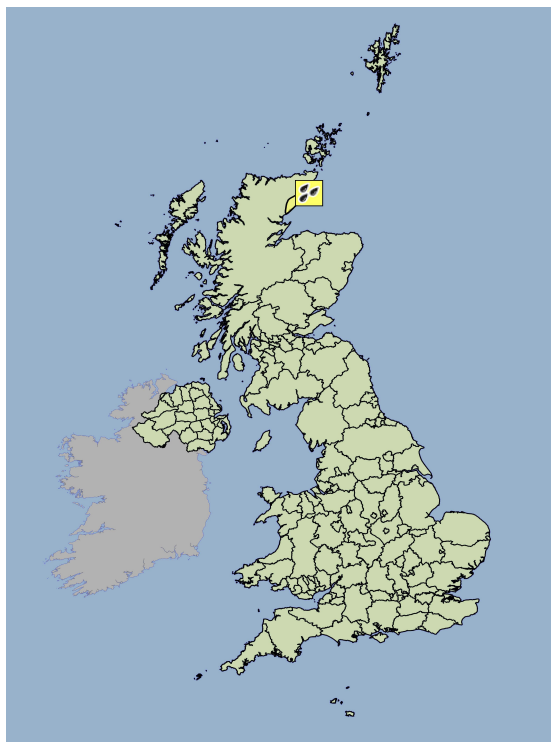




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A frontal system is expected to move into northeast Scotland on Friday night and persist into Saturday, before slowly clearing during the afternoon. Rainfall totals are likely to exceed 40mm, with locally 60mm falling.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Sat, 19th Oct 2013** until **15:00 on Sat, 19th Oct 2013**

A period of heavy rain will affect the high ground of Caithness through Friday night into Saturday morning.

The public should be aware of the potential for some localised flooding.
