Headline:

Mostly dry, chilly night. Rain spreading to N.Ireland later.

This Evening and Tonight:

Largely dry with sunny, then clear spells. Becoming chilly, some ground frost. Rain reaching N.Ireland later.

Tuesday:

Wet, windy weather over N.Ireland spreading across northern and western Britain. Fine elsewhere initially, but becoming increasingly cloudy with some showers.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Mostly rather cloudy with scattered showers. Driest and sunniest in northern England and eastern Scotland. Cloudy with risk of rain in the northwest.
