Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mainly dry with sunny spells and isolated showers across southern parts today. Rain, locally heavy, elsewhere slowly clearing eastwards. Windy over northern England. Temperatures around normal. Mainly dry with clear spells tonight. Chilly in the north and east. Cloud, rain and strong southerly winds spreading over western parts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Cloud and rain, locally heavy, will spread across all parts on Saturday. Brighter weather with sunshine and showers will follow to northern districts. Breezy.

Cloudy, wet conditions will spread northeastwards across the UK during Sunday with sunny spells and blustery showers following. Windy.

Temperatures above normal, but feeling cooler in the wind.
