

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 21 Dec 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain and drizzle, with this steadily becoming confined to west-facing coasts and hills. Some heavier rain is likely across northwest Scotland. A few places to the east of high ground brightening up this afternoon, as milder air spreads to all parts. Little change overnight, with mainly cloudy skies and mild temperatures nationwide.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Another mild but rather cloudy day on Thursday, with the best of any brightness again to the east of high ground. A band of heavy rain will sink southeastwards on Friday, introducing colder air. Showers, occasionally wintry, following on to the north.
